- 9. Equine Education and Therapy.
- 10. Lechee Attacks Trash T-shirt, Trash Bags
- 11. Repairs and Maintenance to the Water Truck (to be utilized for water hauling during the hot summer months for community members who live in the rural areas, when needed)
