Renee inquires which party will be responsible for maintenance. As of now that has not been determined, but Logan replies that ADOT should be the responsible for the maintenance. Since we have been working on this project from the beginning it has not been made clear on who will maintain the turnouts. We will continue to work ADOT & NDOT to get a better understanding. Irene asks if Taadidiin tours is going to match any monetary money for the project. Logan explains he had a deep conversation with Delegate Otto Tso on how the Sahasin funds transfer for infrastructure and economic growth, which will provide the Nation with additional revenue. Delegate Herman Daniels will be sponsoring the Legislation at the Council level. Since Delegate Herman Daniels and the previous Delegate Paul Begay were working on this project from when it first started. This resolution will go through its proper process to get all approvals before the project starts up. We have been working on this for the past six years. Our own local community member Rhoda Tso who is the Engineer with Wilson & Company out of Albuquerque, New Mexico is currently working with us. This is where the cost estimate of the project came from. Presentation was provided, and will be provided during the regular meeting scheduled for next week on July 14, 2025. All attachments for the presentation will be provided with the supporting resolution.

#### Comments:

Holly commends Taadidiin Tours on their hard work and thinking of our community members and visitors. Request that LeChee officials and the chapter administration keep working on Navajo Nation Sales Tax money that belongs to this community, in this community.

Javin Ettsitty comments:

"Permit holders currently have no real rights or protections. Navajo Nation Parks and Recreation seems to be disregarding the concerns of both business owners and permit holders. Our community lacks representation at the Window Rock level to advocate on our behalf, particularly in matters related to tourism and economic development. Even when LeChee Chapter passes resolutions, there appears to be no follow-through at the Window Rock level—it's unclear what happens to those resolutions once they're submitted."

Renee provides an update on the Chapter's push for the LeChee Community to get taxation. This process has been going on for the past 15 years.

"Grazing Official Tyler Manson provided a brief overview of the Navajo Nation Parks boundaries, noting that it has been several years since these boundaries were originally established. He explained that the area extending from Highway 160 on the east side of Shonto to the Colorado River is considered within the Navajo Nation Parks boundaries. This designation includes surrounding communities and grazing areas. Further research is recommended for a clearer and more comprehensive understanding."
