A. Grazing Official Tyler Manson

Current inspection for auction off the reservation needs to contact the rangers. Get inspections a week or two prior to selling your animal. Call Rangers at (928)871-6491. Documents needed to verify it belongs to you, Grazing permit, if in probate need to provide proof that the permit is in probate or bill of sale or a final court decree. Grazing officials no longer have the ability to do inspections.

Home Site Leases, currently the Home Site Lease Process is being amended. Currently the Grazing official is the first person to contact to start the HSL process but in title 3 of Navajo Nation agriculture and livestock, it does not state that the grazing official is not the person to hold this

position. Now the Navajo Nation of Agriculture will have a leasing agent to replace the grazing official. Within the proposed statement it reflects ½ mile radius.

District One Grazing Meeting; Kiabeto Chapter March 27, 2026

Community members brought up customary land use rights. The Department of Economic Development is taking away our grazing land use. This new document that is made from the house is not transparent, tour operators are discouraged to fight for land or will lose their permit. Are the leaders aware of what is going on? As a grazing official I have dealt with individuals that have customary use rights and traditional use rights, and the overreach with the Navajo Nation Government.

Navajo Nation CHID project, currently working on work order 3. Two community members received homes. Wood is still available if needed. Going to start advertising for Summer Youth for June and July. Apple Seed program will come and they will clean people's yards, sign up with Christine at the Chapter.
