 - A. **Summer Youth Employment Program** Today 10 students from the community were hired in. This position has been advertised since June 3rd. Orientation took place, they will all start work on July 8th, 2019.
 - B. Community Cookout is scheduled for July 20, 2019 Flyers are posted in the chapter lobby for more information.
 - C. **Western Navajo Nation Drought Meeting** The next meeting is scheduled for July 9th, 2019 @ 9:00 am (DST). Location of meeting is at highway 98, off mile post 321 by Alaster Secody resident, pot luck. Topics to be discussed dry ponds, broke down windmills, and future planning for Grazing Permit holder's needs. All Grazing Permit holders are to attend, and your input is needed with this planning.
 - D. **LeChee Grazing Official reports** Attended the WNA Drought meeting in Tuba City last month. The main focus of the meeting was to get the chapter officials and chapter manager work with all grazing permit holders and come up with a 5 to 10 year plans on the drought problems for livestock. During this meetings the community will address issues they are having due to the drought. Examples of what needs to be addressed are
 - Dry Pond maintenance.
 - Repair Windmills keep up the maintenance.
 - GPS all livestock corrals, rural homesite leases, gravesite lease, church site leases.
 - Future water/sewer lines land withdrawals.

There is funding available to our community to assist us with these drought issues. A committee should be formed to start developing a plan to request the funding. Other WNA chapters have already received funding for their projects.

JoAnn Yazzie-Pioche – Mentioned that Angie can help us develop a plan. She has helped the Leupp Chapter get the funding they needed. There is approximately \$40 million dollars budget out for any new projects for the drought issues on Navajo Nation. The Navajo Generating Station/SRP water line project will take some years before LeChee can start using, so this Drought project is something the chapter and grazing permittee's should start planning an develop a plan to get funding.

 - Navajo Nation President Nez site visit with SRP/NGS, meeting was held at onsite at the Warehouse building. It was made clear that all agreements to keep the following buildings on site after the demolition, Warehouse, Maintenance Building, Administration Building, RR Building, and Engine House. These agreements were made in the previous administration. All infrastructures left on site will not have utilities, such as electricity, water and sewer. The agreement indicated that SRP/NGS would try to leave the site as it was before the infrastructures were built. But since Navajo Nation Administration is requesting the buildings they will be left onsite. JT Willie is the contact person for any additional requests. A representative from Antelope Point Marina requested to have the Navajo Nation give them the Warehouse Building. The meeting was moved to Antelope Point Marina for further discussions. For our chapter to request large equipment would be too costly and with our budget we as a LGA Certified Chapter it would be more of a loss.
